**How to Protect from Claims of Self-Dealing**

There are a few safe harbor rules that a trustee can follow to ensure that they will not be accused of self-dealing. First, a trustee can engage in an action that might otherwise be categorized as self-dealing if the trust instrument authorizes it. Second, a trustee can seek the approval of the trust beneficiaries for any action or inaction. Finally, a trustee can seek court approval of their actions.

Nevertheless, any trustee looking to protect themselves from claims of self-dealing would be wise to avoid any transaction in which they stand to benefit unless the trust instrument specifically authorizes such action or they are transparent about the transaction and the beneficiaries consent to it.
