POLICE CALLS

Dane County deputies have located a missing Burke man after issuing an alert early in the morning on Sept. 8.

Lt. Don Dudley of the Dane County Sheriff's Office said the department asked for the public's assistance in locating Taylor R. Haberman, 24 of Burke.

Dudley said Haberman was last seen during the evening of Sept. 6, 2021. He is believed to be driving a gray Chevrolet Silverado truck with a license plate of I P2670.

Haberman was described as a white male, approximately 5'8", weighing 150 lbs.

Haberman did not tell anyone where he was heading but he is an avid waterfowl hunter and may have taken his truck and camouflage colored kayak to an area hunting location, according to Dudley.

The Dane County Sheriff's Office asked the community and hunters to be on the lookout for Haberman, his truck and kavak.

About mid-morning on Sept. 8, the county issued an update: Haberman was located and is safe.

"We would like to thank everyone who called with information," Dudley added in the update.

City man gets firearm theft, domestic, bail jumping charges

Dane County authorities issued disorderly conduct, domestic battery, felony bail jumping, domestic disorderly conduct, misdemeanor bail jumping, intimidation of a victim and firearm theft charges against a 29-year-old Sun Prairie man in connection with a Sept. 6 incident at Park Circle.

According to the criminal complaint and Sun Prairie Police Sgt. Brandon Lingle, officers responded to the 1500 building at Park Circle just after 6 p.m. to investigate a domestic disturbance.

A female told police the father of her children, Tyshon Saffold, arrived at her apartment and she believed he was under the influence of controlled substances. She confronted him about her belief he was under the influence of drugs. He disagreed and adamantly told her he was not under the influence of drugs. She stepped out to briefly speak with her kids who were in the living room of the apartment. Upon her return to the bedroom, she observed the defendant handling her 9mm pistol which she had kept in a purse on her nightstand. She told him he needed to give the gun back, at which point he threw her purse across the room towards the closet and put the firearm in his waistband. He began walking towards the bedroom door, at which point she continued to tell him he needed to give the gun back and stood in front of the door to prevent him from leaving with it.

A struggle between Saffold and the female took place, and when she attempted to call 911, Saffold pulled the phone from her hand and disconnected it. Police logged the call at 6:01 p.m.

Saffold allegedly took the phone and attempted to leave the residence, followed by the female victim. The complaint states Saffold grabbed her by the neck twice, then threw her to the floor, and

left the apartment with the firearm

Lingle said police later located Saffold in Madison without the firearm, placed him under arrest and transported him to the Dane County Jail to be held on the charges.

Saffold has bail conditions which prohibit him from having contact with the female victim, possessing a firearm or violating any laws.

He was previously charged April 27 in Dane County Circuit Court with possession of heroin with intent to deliver and on Jan. 4 with theft of movable property valued at less than \$2,500.
