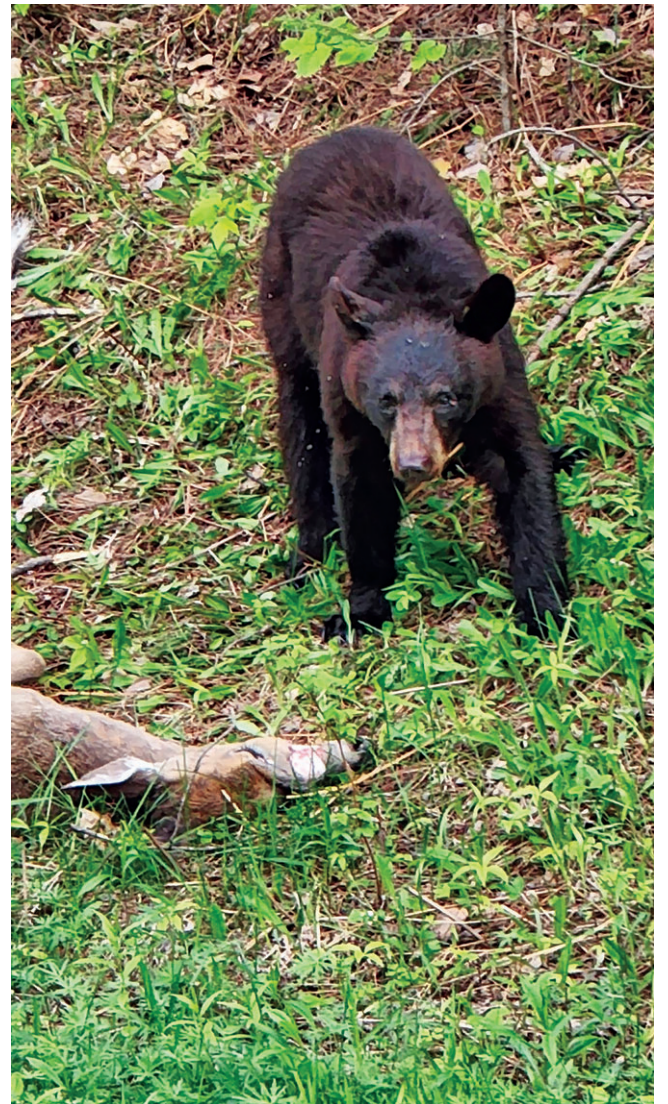


Roadside dining for Perkinstown bear family

A sleuth of bears stopped by CTH M near Perkinstown on Saturday afternoon for a roadside snack. A juvenile black bear was working hard to drag a road kill deer carcass into the woodline along CTH M about a mile east of the road to the Chippewa Campground. The bear was under the watchful eye of a much larger mature bear while at least one other juvenile bear played in the woods. While normally docile, black bears can be dangerous if disturbed. People are advised to avoid contact with them.
