The 18-hole mini-golf course starts in a park setting before users "fall inside a rabbit hole" and enter the "wonderfully whimsical room."

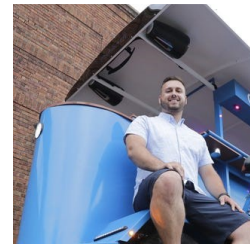
