

Weyerhaeuser Fire Department celebrates addition of new engine

The Weyerhaeuser Fire Department is celebrating the addition of a new fire engine.

It all started in the fall of 2021, when members of the Weyerhaeuser Fire Department and the Weyerhaeuser Fire District 6 started hosting meetings with Custom Fire, Jefferson Fire and Safety-Rosenbauer, and Pomasl Fire-Pierce, to design and price out a new fire engine. After several meetings and discussions with the above manufacturers, it was decided by the committee members to award the bid to Jefferson Fire and Safety who is the sales group for Rosenbauer.

In December 2021, Weyerhaeuser Fire Department Chief Bob Bush placed the order for a new 2023 Rosenbauer fire engine.

After the truck was ordered, Fire District President Tom Meisner-Big

Bend, Fire District Secretary/Treasurer Robert Babcock and Fire Chief George Murray contacted Senior Vice President of CCF Bank Paul Swartos, to begin the process of financing the new truck. The FD was directed to Cole Paulson at the CCF branch location in Barron. Paulson was the department's main contact for the duration of the financing process. The final paperwork was then transferred to the Ladysmith CCF branch to make it easier to sign documents.

The Weyerhaeuser Fire District had set aside funding in previous years to pay for the 2023 Freightliner chassis up front. Planning ahead saved the fire district

\$396,000 on the total purchase price.

In October of 2022 Assistant Chief Bob Buch, Tom Jackson and Bob Burdorf traveled to Lyons South Dakota and met at the Rosenbauer plant to complete a mid-build walk through. The opportunity to see the engine midway through the assembly process allowed the department to make any final changes.

In December 2022, Fire Chief Murray was contacted by James Schulenburg of Jefferson Fire and Safety, and he said the new fire engine was ready and asked members of WFD to travel to the Rosenbauer plant in South Dakota for a final inspection.

If the FD didn't find any issues with the new en-

gine, it would be brought to its new home in the garage of WFD.

Near the end of December 2022, James Schulenberg and Doug Quam of Jefferson Fire and Safety came to Weyerhaeuser and showed the firemen how to operate the new pumper.

Once WFD members were trained on the new truck, it was loaded with firefighting equipment and a new radio was installed by General Communications out of Eau Claire.

The new 2023 Rosenbauer pumper fire engine was put to work in January of 2023. The new engine replaces the 2002 Pierce which will now be a backup engine for the FD.
