

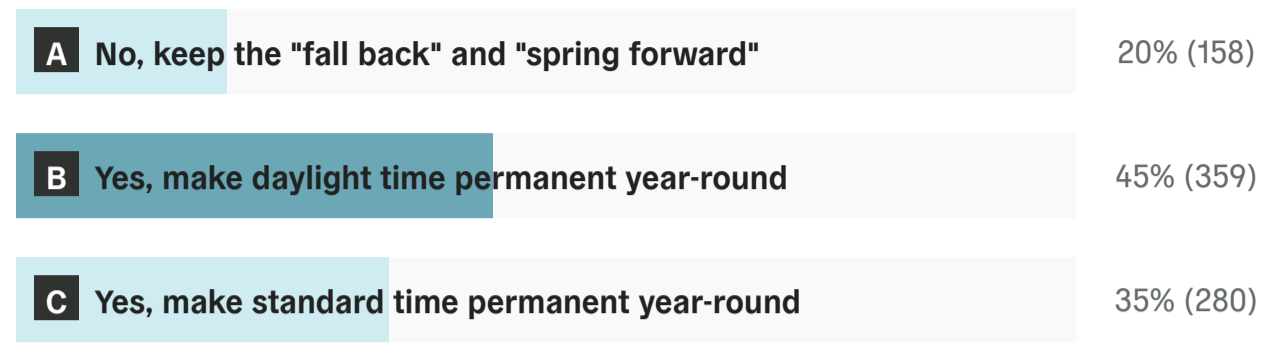

Overview

Breakdowns

Gender

Responses broken down by the gender of the respondent. Currently, most public data only supports male, female, and unknown.

Female

A No, keep the "fall back" and "spring forward"	15% (52)
B Yes, make daylight time permanent year-round	45% (153)
C Yes, make standard time permanent year-round	39% (132)

Male

A No, keep the "fall back" and "spring forward"	23% (75)
B Yes, make daylight time permanent year-round	46% (150)
C Yes, make standard time permanent year-round	30% (98)

Unknown

A No, keep the "fall back" and "spring forward"	23% (31)
B Yes, make daylight time permanent year-round	41% (56)
C Yes, make standard time permanent year-round	36% (50)
