



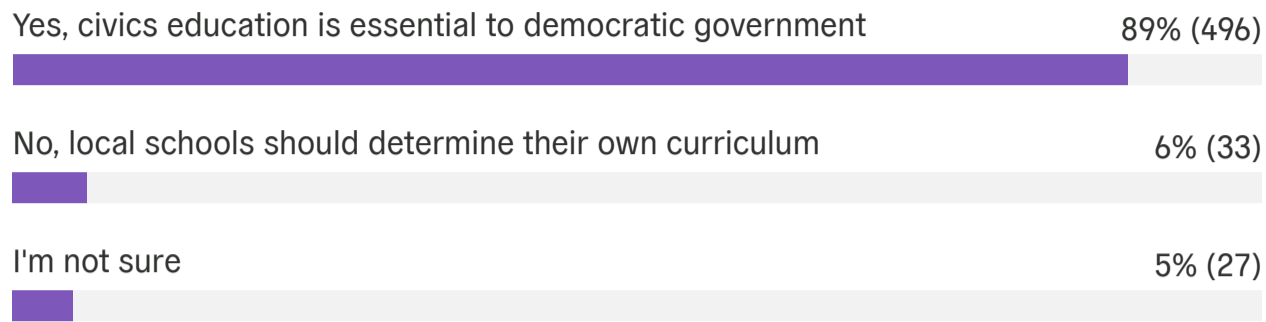

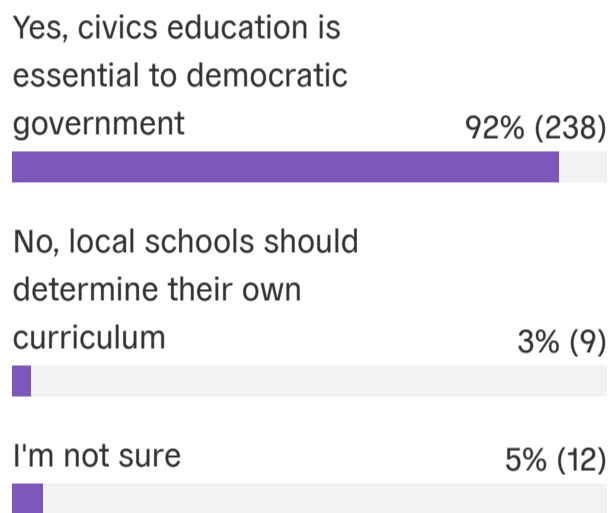

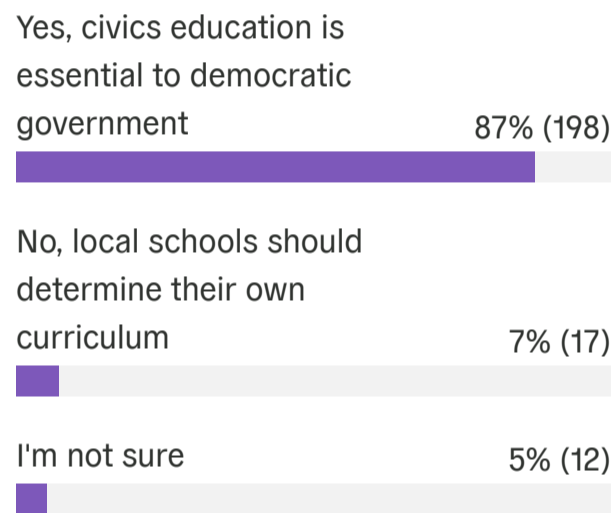
Gender

Responses broken down by the gender of the respondent. Currently, most public data only supports male, female, and unknown.

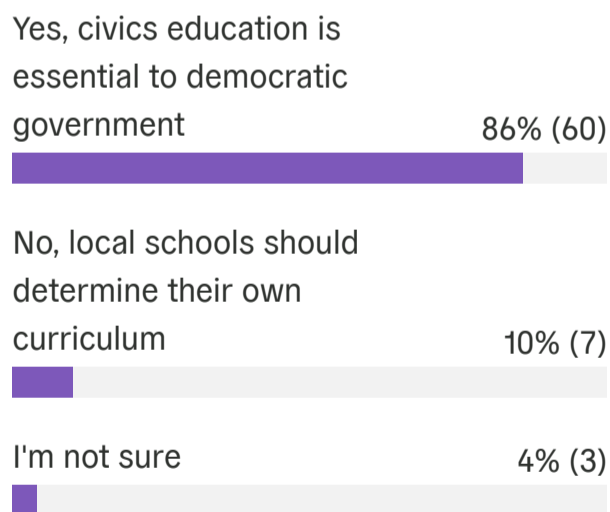
Female
