New sports editor Andrew Ringgold

Andrew Ringgold is joining the Courier Press as the new Sports editor. Many in the community know Andrew as the owner of Aringo Photos which provides online chronological portfolios of local athletes. The service began with USA Swimmers nationally and Texas hockey players of the IC-SHL.

Andrew received a Bachelors of Arts degree in International Relations. The Distinguished Military Graduate from the University of Nebraska-Lincoln originally hails from Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. Andrew operated within various disciplines while serv-

ing in the US Air Force and US Army. These areas included Intelligence, Electronic Warfare/Combat, and Air Defense as a P.A.T.R.I.O.T. missile commander. In addition to his career activities, Andrew founded the Aringo Grand Alliance and associated organizations providing opportunities to home educated youth and their family members. Andrew rebranded the Aringo Grand Alliance, LLC (established in 1995) and established the Aringo Grand Alliance, Inc. in February of 2019, creating and launching Aringo Real Estate Hold-

ings, Aringo Transportation Alliance, Aringo Fleet Leasing, and Alliance Logistic Solutions.

Andrew joined BNSF Railway as a Senior Manager in 1999 following a career in the United States military. He served in various roles spanning transportation, engineering, mechanical, operations, and sales disciplines. Andrew joined Eagle Global Logistics (now Ceva Logistics) in 2006 serving as manager of the International Gateway and led the design and construction of the DFW facility. In 2010, Andrew moved to Hammer Down Delivery Services as the Vice President of Business Development and assisted in the company's expansion through the

acquisition of three rival organizations. Andrew transitioned to MW Logistics as the Vice President of Operations in 2011 and within weeks of joining was also appointed as the Vice President of Sales. During this period, the company experienced its highest level of revenue each successive year. In 2016, Andrew was named Chief Operating Officer at Mike Tamana Freight Lines to map and launch their strategic growth initiative. Andrew was named to his position at Arrive Logistics in October 2017. In this capacity, Andrew cultivated business opportunities through relationships and interaction with Fortune 500 and other business leaders.
